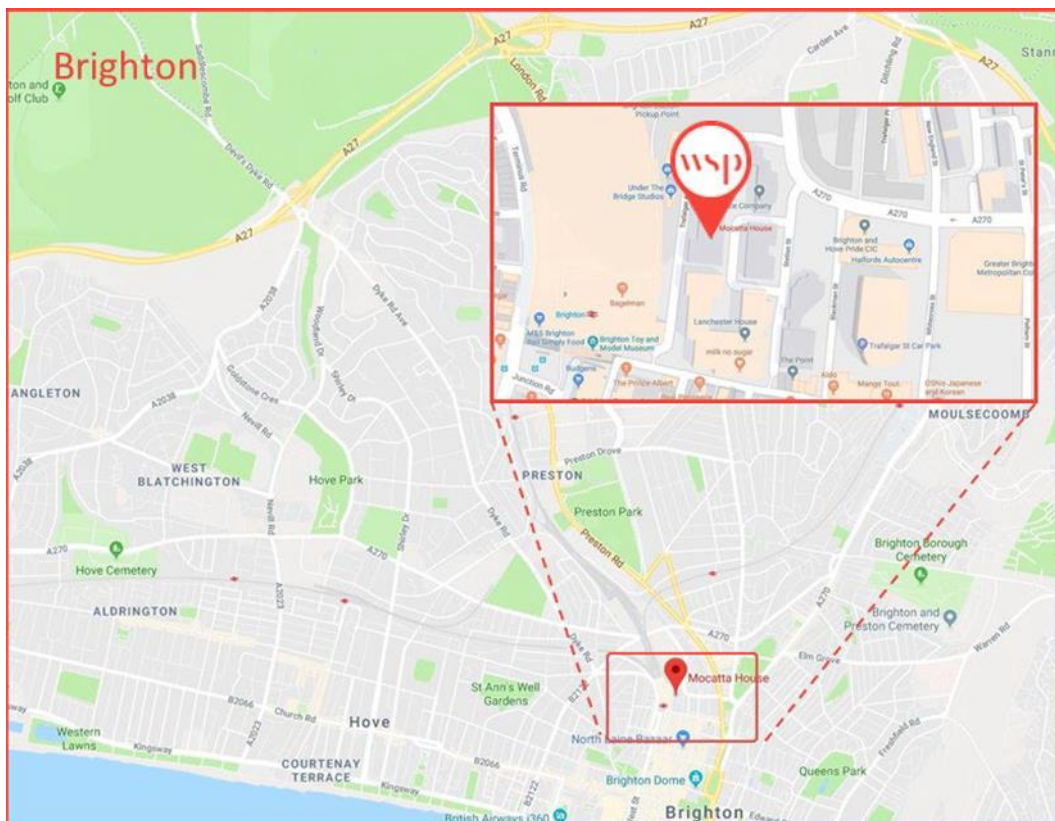
We are delighted to be welcoming you to the Brighton office of WSP.

## TRAVELLING TO BRIGHTON

### By Car

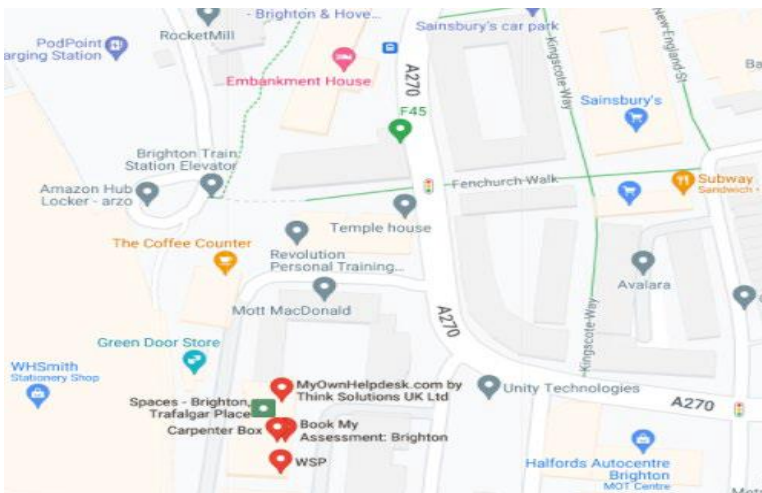
If coming from London or Gatwick Airport, Brighton can be reached via the M23 and then the A23. The A27 that runs parallel to the South coast allows good car access to the East (Eastbourne) and West (Southampton). Central Brighton is a very busy area and as such it is advisable to allow plenty of time to access the site if you are attending during the traditional “peak hour” periods.

### Parking

It is Company policy to reverse park in all our office parking facilities, where practicable. Where parking spaces are adjacent to pedestrian walkways or ‘safeways,’ then please ensure that your vehicle does not overhang or impede the walkway.

### Parking Arrangements

There are no parking facilities currently available currently at the Brighton office. Sainsburys offers 90 minutes of free parking and is only a 4 minute walk from the office, otherwise the Rail station car park is the most amenable alternative. ### By Train

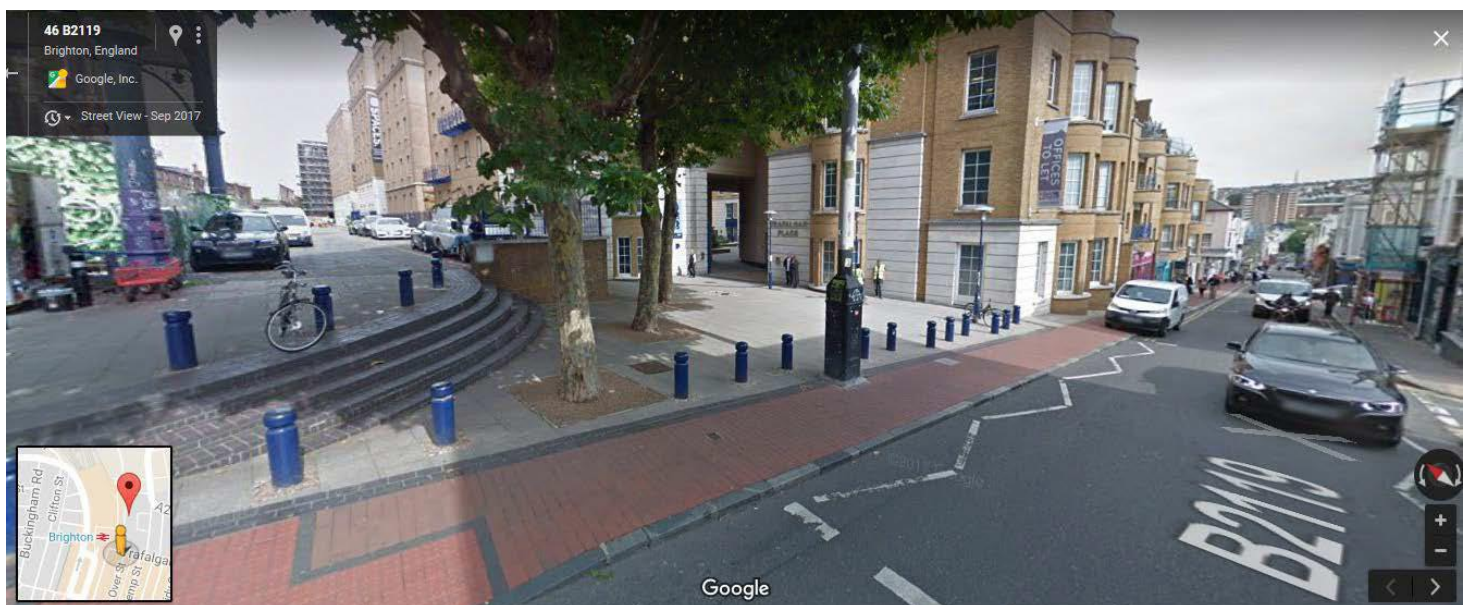
Brighton is part of the Southern Network and has links to London, Gatwick, and various stations throughout the South.

The office is approximately a 5 minute walk from the railway station. Exit the station on the right-hand side via Marks and Spencer then turn immediately down Trafalgar Street (B219) for approximately 150m, passing underneath the rail line (see Image 1 below). You then turn left through an archway into Trafalgar Place (see pedestrian passageway in centre of Image 2) where the front entrance to Mocatta House reception can be found approximately 180m up on the left-hand side.

## By Bus

Brighton has an extensive bus network both within the city and to the towns and villages beyond.

The number 12 and 12X buses go from Eastbourne to Brighton. First bus from Eastbourne to Brighton is 05:34 and runs every 10 to 15 mins until 08:00 then about every 20 mins. This goes from Eastbourne town centre to Brighton Station, but after 07:30 to Churchill Centre.

Going back from Brighton the bus leaves from Churchill Square (Stop E) every 10 mins from 16:50 to 18:00, then every 20 mins. The last 12X leaves at 18:35 but the 12, which is a bit slower, continues to run. Travel time is about 1 hour 15 mins on the 12X and about 5 or 10 mins more on the 12.
