



TRAVELLING TO EDINBURGH



By Car

Edinburgh Park lies adjacent to Edinburgh's City bypass (A720) at its junction with the A8 Glasgow Road. The City of Glasgow lies a 45-minute drive to the west.

Parking

It is Company policy to reverse park in all of our office parking facilities, where practicable. Where parking spaces are adjacent to pedestrian walkways or 'safeways', then please ensure that your vehicle does not overhang or impede the walkway.

By Train

Travel by rail to and from the Edinburgh office is easy.

Edinburgh Gateway train station is less than 10 minutes' walk and has the added benefit of being directly on the tram route and only 4 tram stops from the Airport. Trams to Haymarket Railway Station or St. Andrew's Square for Edinburgh Waverley Railway Station run every 3-7 minutes between 06:20 and 19:30. Trams run every 10 minutes outside of these times between 05:00 and 24:00 Monday to Friday. Weekend timetables are similar, but trams run slightly less frequently.

South Gyle Railway station is a 20-minute walk from the office. Edinburgh Park Railway station is a 20-minute walk from the office. Both stations are serviced by the free Park Shuttle Bus (details in the section below).

Waverley Station in the city centre is Edinburgh's main railway station where many trains from further afield terminate. Both Edinburgh Park and South Gyle stations are less than a 10-minute train ride on direct routes from Waverley.

By Bus

Skylink 300 - Ocean Terminal to Ingliston Park and Ride via Gyle Centre

Lothian Bus fares are charged at £1.70 for a single and £4 for a Day ticket. A day saver ticket can also be used on the trams. Premiums apply for journeys to and from the airport.

First Bus 21A Edinburgh Park to Fauldhouse

Edinburgh Park also has a free Shuttle Service which runs at peak hours and services the local train stations and offices.

- Mon Fri from 07:20 9:30 and 16:00 18:15
- 2 buses run from Edinburgh Gateway & South Gyle stations. There are no specific stops but the bus. should stop at each building if required. Both buses run in a loop system and operate, approximately, every 15 minutes.



By Metro/Underground/Tram

The Edinburgh tram route runs from the airport to the city centre. Edinburgh Trams

Gyle Centre is the closest tram stop to the office, and it takes 25 minutes from the city centre to Edinburgh office, or 15 mins from the airport to the office.

Tram tickets cost £1.80 single, £4.50 DAYticket (usable on Lothian buses as well). A single ticket to the airport stop is charged at £6.50 or £9.00 return. This is a very cost-effective transport mode to get into Edinburgh unless a group of travellers is sharing taxi costs.

Directions to Edinburgh Office from the Tram Stop

Alight the tram, walk up the ramp to the dual carriageway and use the pedestrian crossing to get over to Edinburgh Park.

Walk towards the office buildings, turn right at the end of the pathway, and follow it around with the Ibis hotel on your right. Walk to the end of this walkway, turn right and No 7 Lochside View is in front of you.



Where is it?

Gyle Shopping Centre lies to the west of Edinburgh city centre. Signs will direct you to the tram stop on South Gyle Broadway. This is the main road right beside the shopping centre car park.

What's nearby?

By Plane

The office is approximately a 10-minute drive by car or taxi from Edinburgh Airport. The airport is also connected direct to the office by the tram, the closest stop being Gyle Centre.

By Bicycle/Scooter

Cycle racks are available in the basement car park and on the ground floor level at the front of the building. There is a secure cycle store in the basement. No bicycles will be permitted within the floor plate.

By Taxi
