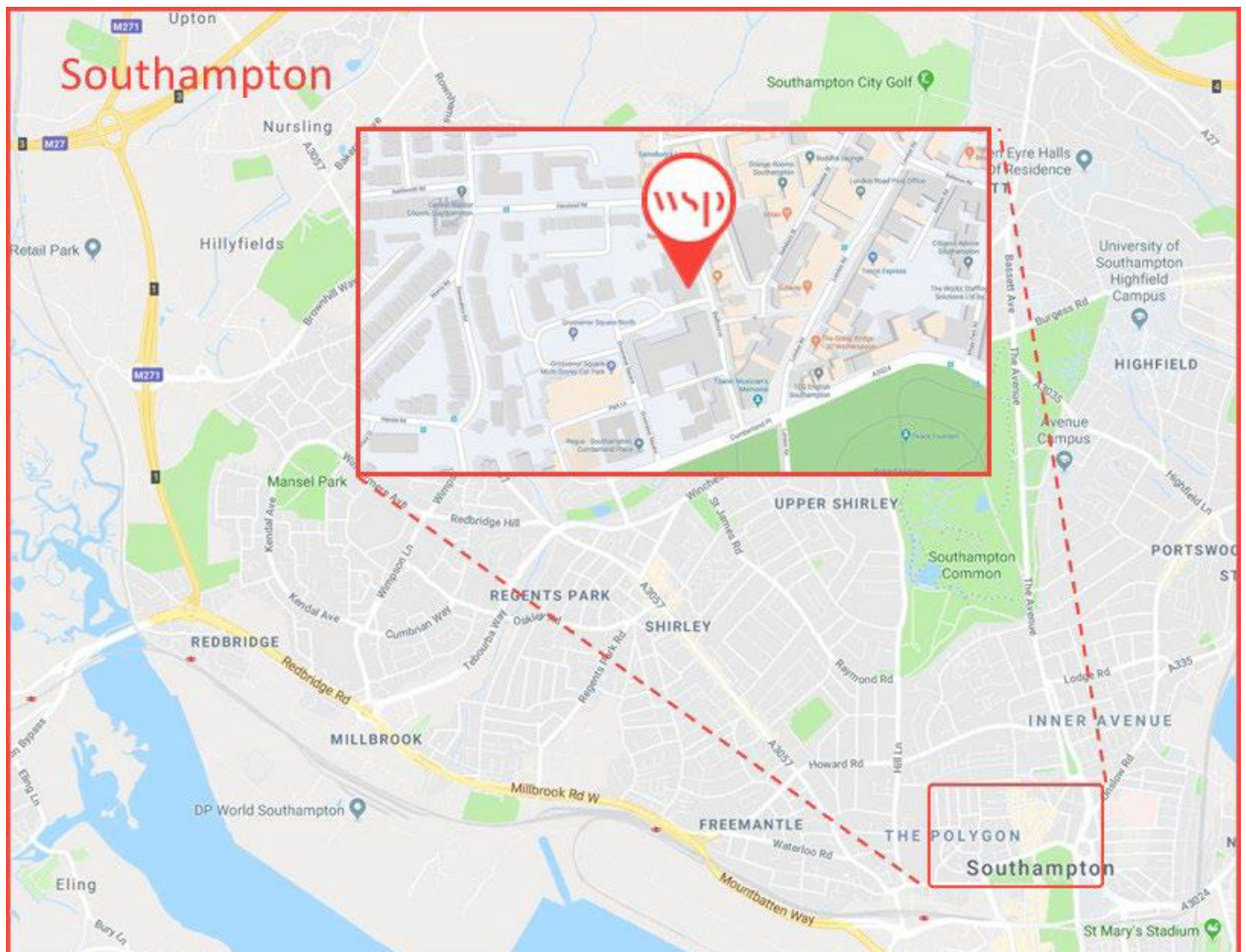

TRAVELLING TO SOUTHAMPTON

By Car

Southampton has excellent road links, with access from both the M3 and M27 motorways. Using satellite navigation please use post code **SO15 2BE**.

From M3

Follow signs to Southampton and the City centre (A33). At the Charlotte Place Roundabout follow signs for Ring Road (West). From the roundabout, at the second set of traffic signals turn right into Bedford Place. Turn left into Grosvenor Square and the WSP office is on the right. Follow the road around the roundabout to access the client/visitor car park to the left of the main office entrance. The car park is barrier controlled and reception will allow you to access the car park if a space is booked. Alternative parking is available at Grosvenor Square multi-story car park, located in the same square.

From M271

Follow signs to City centre (A33). Once past the Southampton Central follow signs for Ring Road and Grosvenor Square car park.

Parking

It is our policy to reverse park in all our office parking facilities, where practicable. Where parking spaces are adjacent to pedestrian walkways or 'safe ways,' then please ensure that your vehicle does not overhang or impede the walkway.

Parking Arrangements

Public parking is available within the city centre. The closest facilities are at Grosvenor Square and Bedford Place, both multi-storey car parks. Other locations are provided on Southampton City Council Website. <https://www.southampton.gov.uk/roads-parking/parking/>

By Train

The office is located within close proximity of Southampton Central rail station, accessible within a comfortable 10 minute walk. Southampton Central rail station is served by direct trains to and from cities across the country. Services passing through the station include:

- Southwestern Railway services to London Waterloo (approximately 1 hour 20 minutes), Bournemouth (approximately 30 minutes) and Winchester (approximately 17 minutes).
- Great Western Railway services to Bristol (approximately 1 hour 40 minutes), Portsmouth (approximately 50 minutes), Brighton (approximately 1 hour 50 minutes) and Salisbury (approximately 30 minutes).
- Cross Country Train services to Birmingham (approximately 2 hours 30 minutes), Oxford (approximately 1 hour 20 minutes) and Manchester (approximately 4 hours 7 minutes).
- The local rail network services many suburbs and towns on the periphery of the city including Eastleigh, Chandlers Ford, Romsey, Woolston and Redbridge, as well as to Southampton Airport. For timetables, train fares and tickets for any UK train services visit National Rail Enquiries.

By Bus

Local Service

Southampton City does not have a bus station, but most services are within a comfortable 10 minute walk. Timetables and maps of the services available can be found at Southampton's "MyJourney" website. <https://myjourneysouthampton.com/bus/bus-timetables-and-services-southampton/>

National Services

National Express services are available from the NE station on Western Esplanade, located to the south of Southampton Central rail station, accessible within a comfortable 10 minute walk.

By Underground

There are no Metro/Underground/Tram transport links to this office.

By Plane

The closest airport is Southampton International Airport. It takes approximately six minutes by train and around 20 minutes by bus to reach the city centre from the airport. Details of onward travel are available at the airport from their Information Desk.

By Bicycle/Scooter

The closest airport is Southampton International Airport. It takes approximately six minutes by train and around 20 minutes by bus to reach the city centre from the airport.

By Taxi

Hackney Carriage and Private hire taxis are available in Southampton. Uber is also available at Southampton.

By Sea

The city hosts two ferry services to the Isle of Wight and Hythe. The ferry terminals are approximately a 24 minute walk from the office; therefore, a taxi or bus journey may be preferred to connect to these services. The Quay connect service is available within a comfortable 10 minute walk from the office.

Ferry services to and from the Isle of Wight are operated by Red Funnel, departing from Town Quay, with a high-speed service for foot passengers (23 - 25 minutes) and a ferry for vehicles, cyclists, and foot passengers (55 - 60 minutes). The foot passenger service heads to West Cowes, and the vehicle ferry to East Cows. Passengers are advised to book ferries in advance, particularly if travelling by car or over the school holidays, and for major events such as the Isle of Wight Festival.

A half hourly ferry service to Hythe (for access into the New Forest National Park) also leaves from Town Quay. This service is for foot passengers and cyclists only.
