PROFILE

Founded in 1885 and headquartered in New York City, Parsons Brinckerhoff is a leader in the development and operation of infrastructure to meet the needs of clients and communities around the world. The company has approximately 14,000 employees in 150 offices globally, with major regional offices throughout the U.S. and in London, Dubai, Hong Kong, Singapore, Toronto, and Sydney.

ORGANIZATION

Corporate oversight is provided by the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), along with the CEO Committee and the Operating Leadership Committee. The company is organized into individual Operating Companies that serve clients in diverse markets and geographies. Operating units are supported by Global Corporate Services Groups.

SERVICES & SECTORS

Parsons Brinckerhoff provides strategic consulting, planning, engineering, program and construction management, and operations and maintenance services to both public- and private-sector clients. Key markets include: transportation, power/energy, buildings, mining, water and wastewater, environmental, and urban/community development. Parsons Brinckerhoff's Canadian operating company, Halsall, provides structural and restoration engineering, property condition assessment, and green planning and design services for buildings and communities. The firm's U.S. buildings operating company, Heery International, provides architecture, interior design, engineering, and program and construction management services for buildings and facilities.

SELECTED MAJOR PROJECTS

Parsons Brinckerhoff has participated in some of the world's most notable engineering projects, and is currently engaged in large-scale infrastructure programs and smaller community projects throughout the world. Selected recent and on-going projects include:

- **Woodrow Wilson Bridge Replacement:** This \$2.5 billion highway and bridge project outside Washington, D.C. is one of the largest transportation programs in the U.S. Parsons Brinckerhoff is the lead member of the joint venture serving as General Engineering Consultant.
- **Medupi Power Station:** This 4800MW power station in South Africa will be one of the world's largest thermal plants when completed, providing reliable power to a growing population. Parsons Brinckerhoff is providing project management support.
- **Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA):** Parsons Brinckerhoff has long provided housing inspection services to FEMA in the wake of natural disasters. Thousands of inspectors under Parsons Brinckerhoff's direction have generated reports allowing FEMA to determine monetary awards to homeowners.
- **Indira Gandhi International Airport:** Parsons Brinckerhoff served as project management consultant for an extensive modernization program to expand runway capacity and provide a new terminal at India's busiest airport.

- **No. 7 Subway Line Extension:** Parsons Brinckerhoff is providing final design services on this project, a key element in a program to create a vibrant, transit-oriented district on the far West Side of Manhattan in New York City.
- **Credit Valley Hospital:** Halsall provided structural engineering services for the renovation and expansion of this hospital in Mississauga, Ontario. Key elements included 2.5-story-high timber structures that support a roof with significant snowloading.
- **MCGHealth Cancer Center:** Heery's design for this new cancer center in Augusta, Georgia incorporated input from a team of patient advisors, whose perspective helped shape interior and exterior features of the building.
- **Mesaieed Independent Power Project:** Parsons Brinckerhoff served as Owner's Engineer for this combined cycle gas turbine plant, which will provide electricity to Qatar's residents while using innovative technology to reduce nitrogen oxide emissions.
- **New Songdo International City:** This master-planned, sustainable international center of business in South Korea is one of the world's largest private development projects. Parsons Brinckerhoff provided construction management and construction supervision services as well as support for implementation of LEED criteria.
- **Interstate 69:** Parsons Brinckerhoff is leading the design effort on a \$560 million, 55-mile-long new highway construction project in southern Indiana in the U.S., which is being delivered on a fast track.
- **Jacinth-Ambrosia Mine:** Parsons Brinckerhoff worked as part of an integrated project team, to develop this zircon mine and associated infrastructure in a remote part of South Australia—under budget and ahead of schedule.
