NOTIFICATION OF GRANTING AN ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION IN TERMS OF NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT 1988 (NEMA AS AMENDED), AND THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT (EIA) REGULATIONS, 2014 (AS AMENDED) FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF TWO (2) ACCESS ROADS (UNTARRED ROADS) LINKING INTO THE NORTH VENTILATION SHAFT 3 AND SOUTH MERENSKY VENTILATION SHAFT AT THE MODIKWA PLATINUM MINE AND ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURAL ACTIVITIES ON PORTION 281 OF THE FARM HENDRIKSPLAATS 281 KT (ROAD 1) AND PORTION 1 OF THE FARM ONVERWACHT 292 KT (ROAD 2), SITUATED WITHIN FETAKGOMO TUBATSE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY OF SEKHUKHUNE DISTRICT: LIMPOPO PROVINCE

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE), issued on 23 March 2023 and received on 29 March 2023, granted Modikwa Platinum Mine (Pty) Ltd an Environmental Authorisation (EA) in respect of the proposed construction of two (2) access roads linking into the North Ventilation Shaft 3 and South Merensky Ventilation Shaft and associated infrastructural activities on Portion 281 of the Farm Hendriksplaats 281 KT (Road 1) and Portion 1 of the farm Onverwacht 292 KT (Road 2). The project area is located at Modikwa Platinum Mine, Fetakgomo Tubatse Local Municipality of Sekhukhune District, in the Limpopo Province.

As the holder of the EA, Modikwa Platinum Mine, will be required to comply with the Departmental conditions of the EA.

Opportunity to Appeal:
