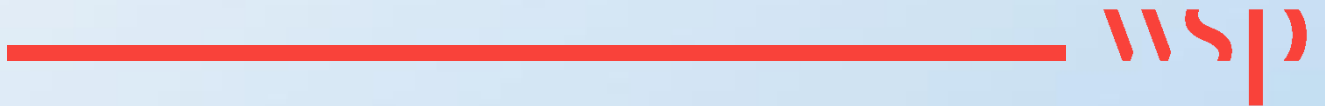

NOTICE OF BASIC ASSESSMENT IN SUPPORT OF A WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE APPLICATION TO DECOMMISSION AND REHABILITATE THE HISTORIC SLURRY PONDS (AREA 5) AT TUBATSE CHROME (PTY) LTD, FETAKGOMO TUBATSE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY, LIMPOPO PROVINCE

Notice issued in terms of the National Environmental Management Act 107 of 1998 (NEMA); the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 (as amended); and the National Environmental Management: Waste Act 59 of 2008 (NEMWA)

BACKGROUND AND LOCATION

Tubatse Chrome (Pty) Ltd (Tubatse), a subsidiary of Samancor Chrome, is a ferrochrome smelting operation situated in the Steelpoort Valley, adjacent to the R555, 2 km south of the town of Steelpoort and 58 km to the north of Roossenekal, in the Limpopo Province. Tubatse produces approximately 375 000 tonnes of ferrochrome annually. The plant, established in 1975, has six submerged arc furnaces, a Chrome Recovery Plant (CRP) and a Pelletising and Sintering Plant (PSP). The CRP slurry ponds (Area 5) was historically used to store thickener underflow from the CRP. These ponds were established in the late 1980's and have been replaced by two concrete silt traps. Tubatse proposes to decommission Area 5 and to remove the waste from the footprint for disposal to the existing licenced hazardous waste disposal facility (referred to as the HH Facility).

Since Area 5 is regarded as a waste disposal facility, the decommissioning of the facility requires a waste management licence (WML) as it triggers Category A, Activity 3(14) of Regulation GN R.921, published under the National Environmental Management Waste Act, 2008 (Act 59 of 2008) (NEMWA) (as amended). Category A waste management activities require a Basic Assessment process, as outlined in GN R. 326 of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations (2014, as amended), for submission to the Department of Forest, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE). A WML for the decommissioning of Area 5 was issued to Tubatse in 2017 (Ref. No. 12/9/11/L60588/5). However, the licence validity lapsed as there were delays in the construction of the HH facility on which the Area 5 material was to be removed to. Tubatse therefore currently seeks to re-apply for a WML to decommission and rehabilitate the CRP historic slurry ponds (Area 5).
