Agricultural specialist input to An Environmental Authorisation Amendment for the authorised Komati Power Station Solar Photovoltaic Facility, Battery Energy Storage Systems, and associated infrastructure Mpumalanga Province

The Komati Power Station Facility received an environmental authorisation (EA) (DFFE:14/12/16/3/3/2/2456) on 02 February 2024. The applicant wishes to amend the Environmental Authorisation for the following:

- Extension of the BESS Area A.
- Removal of the approved on-site substations in Area A and Area B.
- Change in classification (based on changes in extent and capacities) of Solar Farm A and B to Solar Farm A1, A2 and B.
- Proposed development of three new on-site substations (one each in footprint A1, A2 and B)
 and associated overhead and underground cabling (capacity 33 kV) as well as associated
 infrastructure and road access infrastructure.
- Removal of the approved 132 kV grid connection.

SoilZA did not conduct the original agricultural assessment but was appointed to assess whether the proposed amendments would have any influence on agricultural impacts, as originally assessed. All of the proposed amendments will occur within the previously assessed footprint of the development, apart from the expansion of the BESS, which is all within non-agricultural land within the power station precinct. The amendments themselves therefore have zero agricultural impact and consequently have absolutely no influence on the agricultural impacts of the development, as previously assessed.

Our assessment of the impacts of the proposed amendments confirms that:

- 1. The amendments do not change the nature or significance of the impact as previously assessed.
- 2. There are no required changes or additions to the mitigation measures as a result of the proposed amendments.
- 3. There are no required changes to the EMPr as a result of the proposed amendments.
- 4. The proposed amendments are acceptable in terms of agricultural impact.

From an agricultural impact point of view, it is recommended that the proposed amendments be approved.

It should be noted that, in addition to the Environmental Authorisation, the project will require approval in terms of applicable municipal land use legislation. This approval may not be supported by Department of Agriculture because part of the solar facility (PV site A1) occupies existing croplands.
