The heavy mineral concentrate is then trucked to the Tronox Central Processing Plant (CPC) for refinement. The Fairbreeze Mine is supported by a Mineral Separation Plant (MSP) and Smelter, collectively known as the CPC in Empangeni. The main products include titanium dioxide slag, rutile, zircon, leucoxene and high purity iron which are produced for sale mainly to international markets.

Tronox plans to extend its Fairbreeze mining operations to include a surface right known as Heleza Moya. Heleza Moya tenement falls within the approved Fairbreeze mining right and was recently acquired through a sale agreement. Having concluded the sale agreement with the owner, Tronox now plans to incorporate this area into their active mine plan as it lies immediately adjacent to mineable reserves. This inclusion will require an amendment to the approved environmental management program (EMP) to authorise mining activities on this property

The proposed project area is in the uMhlathuze Local Municipality that falls under the King Cetshwayo District Municipality in the province of KwaZulu-Natal. The mining rights area is also bound to the east by the Umlalazi Nature Reserve and Mondi plantations.

The property was under the ownership of Heleza Moya Farming (Pty) Ltd (Mr Grant McMurray), however Tronox has now acquired this farm portion. The total footprint of the current Fairbreeze mining lease area is approximately 4 120 hectares (ha) and Heleza Moya will add approximately 118.6 ha to the mining footprint, where 73.22 ha of this mineral resource has been identified as





the minable reserve. The economical portion and proposed mining area is located towards the northern boundary of the Heleza Moya Farm (along the Fairbreeze B orebody).

In terms of section 38(8) of the NHRA, any activity that requires an assessment of environmental impacts in terms of NEMA, also requires an assessment of impacts to heritage resources. This DESKTOP report refers to existing project information to assess likely impacts to heritage resources and is intended to provide additional information in support of a Notification of Intent to Develop application to the Amafa Institute.

This report is NOT intended to satisfy the requirements of a Heritage Impact Assessment in terms of section 38(3) of the NHRA. The methodology used in this desktop assessment report is included in Appendix 4.

The Draft Basic Assessment Report (DBAR), dated November 2023, has been reviewed by Ezemvelo KZN Wildlife (Ezemvelo). Ezemvelo, as the conservation authority in KwaZulu-Natal¹ (KZN), is mandated to comment on development and land-use changes applications that may adversely impact on the province's biodiversity. It is with this provincial mandate that the following comments are made.

While Ezemvelo does not object to the attachment of the Heleza Moya Farm (i.e. Remainder of Portion 3 of Lot Emoyeni No. 9105) to the existing Mining Right (referenced above), the DBAR is considered incomplete, as it

does not address all areas of potential biodiversity issues. Additional information is required to make an informed and defensible decision. Due to the close proximity of Umlalazi Nature Reserve, Siyaya Estuary and the Tugela Banks Marine Protected Area, as well as potential downstream impacts to these sensitive features of biodiversity concern, Ezemvelo is of the opinion that the DBAR must be expanded upon to ensure that all potential impacts are adequately assessed and appropriate mitigation identified by suitably qualified specialists.

The Umlalazi Nature Reserve and Siyaya Estuary

The Siyaya estuary is located within the Umlalazi Nature Reserve, of which Ezemvelo KZN Wildlife is the management authority. Estuaries provide a variety of diverse habitats, and as such are characterised by high biodiversity and provide a number of ecological services to surrounding habitats and the marine environment, for example the export of detritus, nutrients and sediment to the coastal zone.

Hence Ezemvelo cannot condone or endorse any further negative impacts upon these sensitive environments, which are located within a Protected Area.

Thukela Banks: A Marine Protected Area

In addition to the above, The Thukela Banks Marine Protected Area, is a widened shelf area that contains a number of important habitats such as estuaries, endangered mud banks, mixed sediment areas, rocky reefs and a number of canyons, which stretch from the shelf into the deeper regions of the continental slope. The Thukela Banks acts as the main environment for juvenile prawns once they have left their estuarine environment, and no other area on the South African coast provides such adequate habitat. Along with the prawns found on the Thukela Banks numerous fish species occur, which use this area to mature and spawn, and again these species are not found anywhere on our coast in any significant numbers. The Thukela Banks area is described as an "offshore estuary" and such, is extremely unique.

Threatened Ecosystems and Critical Biodiversity Areas

In addition to the above, while the DBAR has acknowledged the presence of endangered vegetation types and Critical Biodiversity Areas (pg. 90-92) and have avoided these areas, the DBAR has failed to demonstrate whether the distance by which these areas are being avoided is sufficient. In other words, the DBAR has not clearly stated or illustrated that these areas of conservation significance are adequately buffered by the potential impacts of the proposed activity.

Given the above, it is strongly recommended that the DBAR be revised/updated to include the following:

- 1. Input from an appropriately qualified estuarine specialist. An Estuarine Impact Assessment needs to be undertaken for Siyaya Estuary and must:
 - a. take into account the findings of the wetland impact assessment, and
 - b. assess the cumulative impacts to the estuaries (which is vital given the changes in the landscape).
- 2. The classification and determination of water resources (currently being undertaken by the Department of Water and Sanitation, due to be complete in May 2024) must be taken into account in both the hydrology assessment and estuarine assessment.
- 3. The recommendation made in the Surface and Groundwater Hydrology Assessment (Appendix C10, pg. 44) be undertaken as part of BAR process. Particular reference is made to the first three bullet

points, as this information will provide for a better understanding of the impacts on the hydrological system and hence downstream to the estuary (which lies within a Protected Area).

4. Appropriate buffers to threatened ecosystems must be identified and illustrated in DBAR, to ensure that these threated ecosystems are adequately safeguarded. The buffers must be determined by appropriately qualified specialists. Please find attached Ezemvelo's Impact Assessment Guideline for guidance in this regard.

It is requested that Ezemvelo be afforded the opportunity to review and comment on the Final BAR. This letter is submitted without prejudice and Ezemvelo reserves the right to revise and add to these comments should this be deemed necessary.

It is respectfully requested that your office confirms receipt of this letter. Should you wish to discuss any of the points raised above or should any further biodiversity issues arise please do not hesitate to contact our offices.

Please be informed that this correspondence does not constitute Ezemvelo's final comment. Final comment will be submitted upon receipt and review of the information requested above. 1. INTRODUCTION.

Reference is made to the Draft Basic Assessment Report and the Environmental Management Programme received by Mondi South Africa (Pty) Ltd ("**MSA**") on the 12th December 2023. Based on the information presented in the DBAR, it is understood that the Applicant, Tronox KZN Sands (Pty) Ltd, requires Environmental Authorisation (EA) to mine on identified parts of Heleza Moya, located on the Remainder of Portion 3 of Lot Emoyeni No. 9105, uMlalazi Local Municipality within the King Cetshwayo District Municipality, Kwazulu-Natal Province.

1.1 LEGISLATIVE REQUIREMENTS.

It is understood that the Application is being conducted in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) (Act No. 107 of 1998): Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations (2014, as amended in 2017) and the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act (MPRDA) (Act No. 28 of 2002).

2. PROPERTY AND CADASTRAL INFORMATION

Regulation 43(1) of GNR 326 (EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended) notes that, "A registered interested and affected party is entitled to comment, in writing, on all reports or plans submitted to such party during the public participation process contemplated in these Regulations and to bring to the attention of the proponent or applicant any issues which that party believes may be of significance to the consideration of the application, provided that the interested and affected party discloses any direct business, financial, personal or other interest which that party may have in the approval or refusal of the application."

It is noted that that proposed mine extension will be undertaken on Portion 3 of Lot 88, Farm Emoyeni 9105, which is in close proximity to MSA commercial forestry activities.

MSA would like to place on record that it is in support of job creation, but as a responsible company with long term sustainability as a core driver, MSA needs to ensure that any applications within close proximity to MSA afforestation activities, are undertaken with full compliance to the applicable legislation. It is in this spirit of legal compliance and integration of the best practical environmental management options that the following comments are made with regards to the proposed project.

3. FORESTRY CERTIFICATION.

3.1 FSC Certification

MSA is a Forest Stewardship Council ("FSC") certified company. FSC is an international body which requires compliance to stringent environmental and social standards as applicable to forestry management and operations. Environmental certification is a requirement from our customers and thus compliance to these standards and maintaining our FSC certification is key to our business. MSA therefore requires that all external parties undertaking activities on our landholdings, or in close proximity to MSA commercial forestry activities do not jeopardize our certification in anyway whatsoever.

In this regard the EAP, together with their appropriately qualified specialists, are requested to identify and assess the level of risk from ALL proposed activities in terms of direct, indirect, and cumulative impacts, against the FSC Standards. 3.2 PEFC Certification

In addition to our FSC certification, MSA is affiliated and certified with the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC), which is an international, non-profit, non-governmental organization which promotes sustainable forest management through independent third-party certification. The PEFC certification enables MSA to provide the assurance that all forestry operations are managed in line with environmental, social, and economic requirements – balancing people, planet, and profit. 4. PEER REVIEW ON SPECIALIST STUDIES

It is noted that the Noise Compliance Statement, Air Quality Impact Assessment, Terrestrial Fauna Species Study, Terrestrial Plant Species Assessment, Social Impact Assessment, Soil and Agriculture Potential Study Report were conducted "in-house" as the specialists are, or were at some point, in the employ of WSP, the appointed environmental consultancy. The fact that these crucial studies are being undertaken 'in-house' by the EAP raises concerns about the independence of the specialist conducting these studies.

Additionally, based on the information contained in these Specialist Studies, there is no indication if the Studies have undergone Independent External Peer Review. As such, MSA would therefore be inclined to request that measures are put in place to ensure the objectivity of the study findings. Such measures include a requirement that these studies are peer reviewed by independent specialists to ensure the study findings are not biased.

5. STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT SESSIONS

The DBAR does not include any details for public meetings or stakeholder engagement sessions related to the project. The EAP is requested to provide further information in this regard.






