



RAISE Grants

The Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) program is one of several avenues of funding for projects in the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, and is the most competitive discretionary grant program from USDOT.

WSP USA offers demonstrated success with state and federal grant applications. We are adept at showing the benefits that can be realized through funding important infrastructure projects and have helped clients nationwide secure billions of dollars in federal funding and financing for more than two hundred of infrastructure projects. Our teams pave the way for safer, more accessible, affordable and sustainable mobility systems for everyone.



In 2022, WSP supported **29 RAISE applications** in some capacity, including developing the full application package, developing the benefit cost analysis, or higher-level advising on competitiveness. Of these applications, **14 were awarded funds**, totaling **\$228.6 million for our clients**. This nearly **50% success rate** of applications supported is exceptional, considering the success rate of funded applications in 2022 was 18% (936 applications, 166 awards).

By securing \$228M+ in federal grants in FY 2022, and partnering with [Accelerator for America](#), we are helping position our clients to leverage their best-in-class services to support vital infrastructure projects in urban and rural communities. Such funding is transformative for communities across America.



RAISE SUCCESS

WSP is an industry leader in USDOT's most competitive grant program, RAISE. We have supported more than 70 freight rail, intercity passenger rail, transit, highway, bridge and multimodal projects and secured \$1.14+ billion since 2009. Over the history of the program, approximately 6% of all applications were awarded funding. WSP has maintained a success rate well above this national average. For instance, in the 2016 RAISE cycle, approximately 13% of applications supported by WSP were selected; 23% of applications supported by WSP in 2018 were selected; and for the 2022 cycle, our success rate grew to 50%.
